BRYAN IRVIN SENTECED TO 9 YEARS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR AGGRAVATED BATTERY (DEADLY WEAPON) AND TAMPERING WITH EVIDENCE

The Twelfth Judicial District Attorney, Ryan Suggs, announces that on Wednesday, March 26, 2025, District Court Judge Daniel Bryant sentenced Bryan Irvin to 9 years to the Department of Corrections.

On November 26, 2023, Ruidoso Downs Police responded to a shooting at 127 North Central in Ruidoso Downs, County of Lincoln. Additional support was requested, and the investigation was carried out by the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department. Upon investigation, it was learned that Irvin shot the victim in the foot and subsequently fled the scene. Deputies later located Irvin and took him into custody. On November 4, 2024, a Lincoln County Jury convicted Bryan Irvin, 41, of Ruidoso, NM, of Aggravated Battery (Deadly Weapon) and Tampering with Evidence.

The case was investigated by the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department and prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Mikel Ward.
